- Imitation and questioning opportunities.

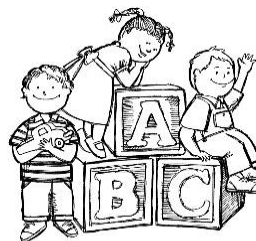

Curriculum

Community Preschool is an outreach ministry of Community United Methodist Church. We have adopted the *Creative Curriculum for Preschool*, published by Teaching Strategies to assist teachers in planning and implementing developmentally appropriate lessons. Developmentally appropriate means teaching in ways that match the way children learn while providing children with opportunities to learn and practice newly acquired skills.

Bible-based lessons that help develop positive character traits are also part of the curriculum.

We want children to have fun and to realize that preschool is a great place to be!



Along with classroom activities we include community field trips. Visits to the Fire Station, Post Office, and the local park help children develop a sense of community. The local librarian, police chief and special guests also come to visit.

The Pastor meets monthly with the children in the church sanctuary for stories, prayer and music.

Family Involvement

We recognize that parents are their children's first teachers. We invite and encourage parent participation. Parents are welcome to join us in the classroom.

In the fall, Parent representatives are selected to serve on the Preschool Board. Representatives assist in developing program policies.

Community Preschool offers a Parents Club. The group meets as needed to discuss items of interest and help plan special activities for our preschoolers and families.

The group also assists with any fund raising activities.

The members of Community United Methodist Church support families through worship, prayer, family programs and "Little Blessings Scholarships".



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
