Parents Club

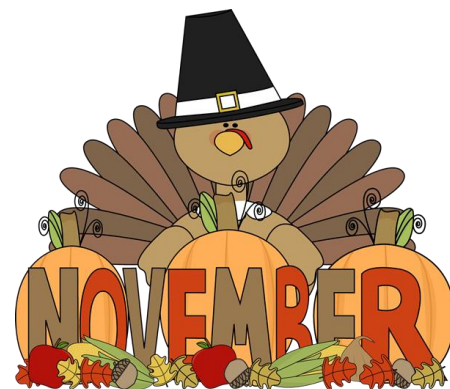
A big thank you goes out to our Parents Clubs for providing our pumpkin patch and Halloween Treat Bags.
