#### Registration

The preschool board met in January to begin planning for the 2022-2023 preschool year. The registration fee is \$40.00. Monthly tuition for the Monday, Wednesday, Friday classes (children age 4 & 5) will be \$135.00.

Monthly tuition for the Tuesday, Thursday classes (children age 3) will be \$105.00.

Registration for families currently enrolled in preschool will begin mid-February, look for registration forms in your child's folder soon! The community will begin registration March 23 from 6pm online, and will remain open until classes are full.

### Open House and Art Show

Unfortunately our annual Open House and Art Show has been cancelled for this year. Typically registration for **new** families begin on these evenings. Please inform your friends interested in Community Preschool for next year; registration will happen online beginning March 23 at 6:00pm. ## Winter Weather Closings

With winter weather upon us we would like to remind you of our policies regarding preschool closings due to inclement weather. Closings will be announced on local television stations. The announcement will say **BROOKVILLE SCHOOLS**. When time permits we will use the Community Safe telephone system to alert parents of closings.

Please let us know if any of your contact information has changed since the start of preschool.

When Brookville Schools announce a **TWO HOUR delay** our **MORNING classes will meet 10am -Noon and our AFTERNOON classes will meet 1-3 pm**

The alley can become a challenge with the snow and ice. Use **caution** as you drive up the alley. Allow more space between cars. Another option is to park in the church parking lot and walk to the door.

## Remember Your Car Tag

As a reminder, it is helpful for staff to see car tags at dismissal time. With reflections from sun and window glare, some tags are difficult to read. We have noticed the **BEST place to display the car tag is on the sun visor or the front passenger window**. Please remind caregivers to display car tags. Don't forget to move your tag from car to car, especially when you get a new car!
